3. Presentation and Adoption of the Honorary Treasurer's Annual Report (2025–2026)

The Secretary and treasurer also requested the house to permit to create an FD of Rupees Ten Lakhs (Rs.10,00,000) out of the amount in savings bank account ISA Karnataka State Branch Account Number: 64026776839 at State Bank of India Tipu Sultan Palace Rd, Chamrajpet of as follows

1. FD Five lakhs
2. FD Three lakhs
3. FD Two lakhs

And to dissolve the necessary FD for establishing a registered office for ISA Karnataka State Branch. They also requested the house to permit to use of the necessary amount required for monthly maintenance of office expenses.

It was unanimously resolved to create the FDs in the said amount in savings bank of ISA Karnataka State Branch and to dissolve the necessary amount FD for

establishing a registered office and to use the necessary amount for monthly maintenance of office expenses.

4. Presentation and Adoption of the Editor's Report

The Editor's report was unanimously accepted as proposed by Dr. Gangadhar S. B. and seconded by Dr Nethra S S.

5. Presentation and Approval of the Audited Accounts of ISACON Karnataka 2025 and PG Excel Karnataka 2026

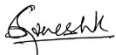

He invited the Treasurer Dr Krishnaprasad to present audited accounts for ISACON Karnataka 2025.

Dr Krishnaprasad presented the audited accounts for ISACON Karnataka 2025 and the report was accepted unanimously after being proposed by Dr Sanikop and seconded by Dr Sandhya K.

The secretary congratulated the Organizing Committee of PG EXCEL 2026 represented by its Chairman Dr Ramesh babu and Secretary Dr Vishwanath for organizing PG Excel Karnataka 2026 successfully and invited organizing secretary Dr Vishwanath to present audited accounts of PG Excel Karnataka 2026.

Dr Vishwanath highlighted the uniqueness of PG Excel Karnataka 2026 in being named as Karnataka PG conference and providing platform for paper and poster presentations for PGs. He also requested the house to permit to present audited Accounts of PG Excel Karnataka 2026 later as it was held just a month ago and still settling the accounts.

6. Presentation and Approval of the report regarding the preparations by the Organizing Committees of PG Excel Karnataka 2027 and ISACON Karnataka 2027

The secretary informed the house that PG Excel Karnataka 2027 has been awarded to Bidar Anaesthesiologistss Society to be hosted by Bidar Institute of Medical Sciences, Bidar and invited the organizing committee represented by Dr Mallikarjun Panshetty to make presentation of PG Excel Karnataka 2027.

Dr Mallikarjun Panshetty made a presentation of preparation for PG Excel Karnataka 2027 highlighting the infrastructure facilities, accommodation facilities for faculty and delegates, connectivity to Bidar etc. He also informed that along with our PGs, it's very convenient for neighbouring states PGs too and invited all members to Bidar.

The report by the Organising Committee of PG Excel Karnataka 2027 was unanimously accepted as proposed by Dr Karthik G. S. and seconded by Dr. Mahesha.K. M.

The secretary informed the house that ISACON Karnataka 2027 has been awarded to Belagavi Anaesthesiologists Society to be hosted by J N Medical College, Belagavi and Belgaum Institute of Medical Sciences, Belgaum and invited the organizing committee represented by Dr Kedareshwar to make presentation on the initial steps of ISACON Karnataka 2027.

Dr Kedareshwar made a presentation of preparation for ISACON Karnataka 2027 highlighting the infrastructure facilities, accommodation facilities for faculty and delegates, connectivity to Belagavi, their organizational experience etc.

The Organising Committee for ISACON Karnataka 2027 was unanimously accepted as proposed by Dr Nethra S. S and seconded by Dr. Smita Patil Koujalgi.

7. Invitation of Bids and Selection of Host Branches for PG Excel Karnataka 2028 and ISACON Karnataka 2028

The secretary informed that the following institutions have bid for PG Excel Karnataka 2028 through their respective City Branches:

1. Ballari Medical College and Research Institute, Ballari
2. BGS Global institute of Medical Sciences, Bangalore
3. Saptagiri Institute of Medical Sciences, Bangalore

Following presentations and mutual agreement by all the bidders, it was resolved unanimously to award PG Excel Karnataka 2028 to Saptagiri Institute of Medical Sciences, Bangalore. The resolution was proposed by Dr. Manjula and seconded by Dr. V. B. Gowda.

The secretary informed that no bids were received for hosting ISACON Karnataka 2028. However, the following institutional heads expressed their interest in consultation with their respective ISA City Branches to host ISACON Karnataka 2028 in the AGBM –

1. Sri Devaraj Urs Academy of Higher Education and Research, Kolar
2. J.J.M Medical College, Davangere
3. Subbaiah Institute of Medical Sciences and Research Centre, Shivamogga

Following mutual agreement by all the bidders, it was resolved to award ISACON Karnataka 2028 to Sri Devaraj Urs Academy of Higher Education and Research, Kolar subject to completion of all necessary formalities in a month failing which next institution will be given chance to host the conference. The resolution was proposed by Dr. Yathish J. K and seconded by Dr. Ananthramaiah T.

8. Consideration of Financial Assistance to Dr. Ganapathi P towards Legal Expenses in Connection with the Narcotic License Issue

The secretary informed that Dr. Ganapathi P was very instrumental in getting the High Court verdict exempting MD Anaesthesiologists from mandatory training in Pain/Palliative Medicine for obtaining or renewing license for Narcotic usage at registered medical institutions. ISA Karnataka awarded him Special Appreciation Award during inaugural ceremony of ISACON KARNATAKA 2026 recognising his contributions.

The secretary informed that based upon executive committee recommendations in its meeting held at Navodaya Medical College, Raichur, a technical report was sought from ISA Mangalore city branch which recommended considering financial

assistance to Dr. Ganapathi P towards legal expenses enclosing certified bill of one lakh fifty thousand rupees.

The house acknowledged the efforts of Dr. Ganapathi P who fought on behalf all anaesthesiologists after representing to state and national bodies. After discussions, the house approved footing 50% of expenses incurred in getting High Court verdict which benefited anaesthesiology fraternity across Karnataka. The resolution was proposed by Dr. Ramesh and seconded by Dr. Sudheesh K.

The house also approved the ISA Karnataka State Branch to bear the expenses that shall be incurred in getting similar exemption for DA and DNB Anaesthesiology degree holders and suggested to approach the High Court through same writ petition and legal counsel.

9. Institution of the ISA Bangalore Metro Obstetric Anaesthesia Award

The secretary informed that ISA Bangalore Metro Branch is desirous of instituting an annual award for the Best Scientific Paper in Obstetric Anaesthesia to be presented during ISACON Karnataka with an objective to encourage postgraduate students and young anaesthesiologists to actively participate in scientific presentations, foster interest in obstetric anaesthesia, and promote research in this important subspecialty of anaesthesiology. To ensure the sustainability of this award, ISA Bangalore Metro Branch proposes to contribute a seed fund of ₹2,00,000 (Rupees Two Lakhs only), which may be invested as a Fixed Deposit. The annual interest accrued from this deposit may be utilized exclusively towards funding the award and associated expenses.

The house suggested the Bangalore Metro Branch to

1. Keep the fund with Bangalore Metro and give the cash prize to the winners.
2. To include young anaesthesiologists (Senior Residents, Assistant professors, private practitioners along with PGs)
3. To decide on the amount of cash prize for the winners

The house suggested the Bangalore Metro Branch to come up with detailed criteria for Award and approved in principle to institute the award from ISACON Karnataka

2027. The resolution was proposed by Dr. Veerabhadraiah and seconded by Dr. Prakash.

10. Presentation and Discussion on the Draft Constitution of ISA Karnataka State Branch

The secretary informed that ISA Karnataka Executive committee had constituted ISA Karnataka CONSTITUTION DRAFT COMMITTEE chaired by Dr P F Kotur along with other members to prepare a draft of ISA Karnataka CONSTITUTION to facilitate its registration as necessitated by ISA National:

The committee had met on several occasions and prepared a draft which was placed in public domain seeking opinions/suggestions/objections/modifications from all members after the approval from Executive Committee.

Subsequent to that, advises/opinions were received from Dr Rangalakshmi and Dr Nagalakshmi N V which were duly acknowledged.

Dr Vijayanand S. raised his concern regarding not involving the five immediate past presidents of ISA Karnataka as there were many issues in recent past. The Secretary informed that the committee consisted of members served at both National and State level and their expertise and experience were very helpful in preparing the draft.

Following discussion, the house resolved to adopt the draft as constitution for ISA Karnataka and to take necessary steps to register ISA Karnataka with the Registrar of Co-operative Societies, Karnataka. The resolution was proposed by Dr. Sanikop and second by Dr. Nethra S. S.

11. Discussion on the Schedule of Elections – ISA Karnataka Election Calendar with ISA National Guidelines (2026)

The secretary informed that ISA Karnataka had released its Election Calendar for elections for 2026 as per the below schedule on 15/6/2026 based on ISA National constitution (2022) schedule of elections for State Branches. Later 08/07/2026, ISA National released a revised calendar for elections of 2026 for State Branches as below. Following which, matter was discussed with ISA National and permission was taken to conduct election as per ISA Karnataka ELECTION calendar and to take approval of AGBM.

In view of the two calenders in force,, the secretary informed that the house needs to decide whether to follow ISA Karnataka Election calendar of 2026 or ISA National calendar 2026 for elections of 2027. The secretary also informed that if ISA National calendar is adopted, ratification of election results by GB may be difficult as the AGBM will be usually scheduled during annual conference of ISA Karnataka during first or second week of August.

After discussions, the house unanimously resolved to follow the Election calendar of 2026 for ISA Karnataka elections as it is suitable for the state affairs. The resolution was proposed by Dr. Vijayananda and seconded Dr. Gangadhar S. B.

12. Guidelines for Selection of the ISA Karnataka Lifetime Achievement Award

The secretary informed that ISA Karnataka annually gives

1. Lifetime Achievement Award
2. Eminent Anaesthesia Teacher Award
3. Freelance Anaesthesiologist of The Year Award
4. Best City Branch Award.

Currently, all the awards have objective criteria for evaluation except Lifetime Achievement Award which is at the discretion of ISA Karnataka Executive Committee.

The Secretary informed that few members have raised concerns over this and suggested to have objective criteria for Lifetime Achievement Award in lines with ISA National Lifetime achievement award and Dr. A. P. Singhal Life Time Achievement National Award.

Following review of criteria used for Dr. A. P. Singhal Life Time Achievement National Award, the house discussed the matter and made few suggestions -

1. To consider the association with ISA at city, state, national levels organizations
2. To consider involvement in various ISA activities like academic, social programmes,
scientific meets, monthly meetings, social outreach programme etc
3. Number of years of anaesthesia professional service rendered in India
4. Contribution to promotion of anaesthesia
5. Details of special activities like medical camp/disaster relief work, health education, rural service, rotary/red cross
6. Development of institution or work place
7. Any other awards received in the field of medicine
8. Involvement in innovative methods in the medical field/medical research/-new services
started
9. Any outstanding service to society.
10. To consider nominations from city branches

Following elaborate discussions, the secretary requested all members to send their suggestions to the ISA Karnataka secretariat email isakarnataka@gmail.com by one month so that after discussions with concerned authorities a format for objective criteria for Lifetime Achievement Award can be made and placed for approval.

13. Consideration of Travel Grants for: Late Dr. T.N. Jha Memorial and Dr. K.P. Chansoriya Medal and Traveling grant AND ISA LUDHIANA BEST POSTER NATIONAL AWARD & TRAVELLING GRANTS travel expenses, actual

V/S Fixed Amount

The secretary informed that the best paper from Karnataka state will be nominated for LATE DR. T. N. JHA AND DR. K. P. CHANSORIYA MEMORIAL NATIONAL MEDAL AND TRAVELLING GRANTS and ISA National gives a grant of Rs.1000/- to each participant to meet the travel expenses. (Actual number of grants varies every year)

Similarly, the best poster from Karnataka will be nominated to ISA LUDHIANA BEST POSTER NATIONAL AWARD & TRAVELLING GRANTS and ISA National gives a grant of Rs. 2,500/- to each participant to meet the travel expenses. (The actual number of grants varies every year).

The secretary informed that last year it was decided to reimburse 3AC train ticket fares from the city where PG is studying to destination of national conference. However, there was a huge discrepancy in the amounts claimed. Therefore, the house was requested to decide upon whether to reimburse 3AC train ticket fare as actual or shall reimburse a fixed amount.

After elaborate discussions, the house unanimously resolved to reimburse an amount of Rs 10000/- (Ten thousand only) EACH as travel grants from ISA Karnataka for the best paper and poster nominated by KARNATAKA State to LATE T. N. JHA MEMORIAL AND DR. K. P. CHANSORIYA MEDAL AND TRAVELLING GRANTS and ISA LUDHIANA BEST POSTER NATIONAL AWARD & TRAVELLING GRANT respectively and the same can be reimbursed for the year 2025. The resolution was proposed by Dr. Nethra S. S and seconded by Dr. Manjunath H. G.

14. Any Other Matter with the Permission of the Chair

The President informed that as per the recommendations of Past Presidents meeting held on 08/08/2026 at VIP Lounge, St John's Auditorium, St John's Medical College, Bangalore, the present structure of annual conference of ISA Karnataka viz workshop (Thursday) + CME (Friday) + Conference (Saturday & Sunday) (Total 4 Days) needs to be revised to Workshop + Conference (Total 3 Days) as CMEs are held regularly in most of cities and institutions on most of the topics. Also, ISA Karnataka regularly holds online monthly webinars.

In addition, relieving the PGs for four days may be difficult as regular OT work needs to be continued in most of the institutions and PGs expect more of hands-on training programmes.

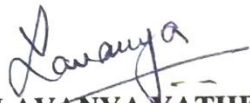
